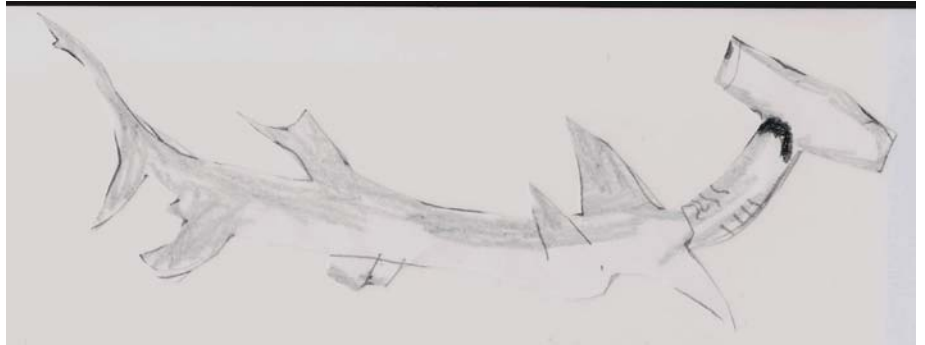


# Save Sharks With Sophi
